### Financial Information (as of 5/1/09)

### Monthly Rates, effective May 1, 2010

- The Authority is funded through collection of monthly sewer service charges, currently at \$42.05 per month per Equivalent Dwelling Unit (EDU). One EDU is equivalent to using 50,000 gallons of water per year.
- Residential premises are billed at a flat rate of \$42.05 per month.
- Non-residential premises are billed based on water consumption, with a minimum being \$42.05 per month.

### Tap Fees, effective July 1, 2010

- The Authority charges a flat tap fee of \$3,070 for residential premises, and \$3,070 per EDU on non-residential premises.
